# School snacks and drinks reminders

In EYFS and KS1 we provide snacks at breaktime and therefore snacks do not need to be sent in by parents. If you feel your child doesn't like school fruit or bagels, then you can send in an alternative piece of fruit, but please don't send in anything else for snack. Also, for drinks during the day it should be water only (not juice or squash). We are following the healthy school advice from the health professionals. Thank you for supporting us with this.

KS2: They also get free bagels, but no fruit so they can bring in fruit or a healthy snack. <u>SERIOUS NUT ALLERGY</u>

We have a child/children in school with a severe nut allergy, therefore, we are reminding parents not to send any foods with nuts in or nut-related products, please check any packed lunches and snacks carefully.

#### <u>PE kit reminder</u>

We are getting quite a few children without PE kits. We recommend that you send them in a kit with their name on (we also sell them), at the beginning of term and that the child then has their PE kit for the rest of the term. They can take it home to wash at the end of the term. We find that prevents them having to remember it each week. Also we need more spare plimsolls - if you have any spare ones, can you please donate to school? Thank you, for your support.

# <u>Uniform and jewellery</u>

#### <u>Attendance</u>

Please fill in a holiday request or an exceptional circumstance form if your child is taking ANY leave from school. Any holidays taken in term time will incur a fixed penalty notice unless there are any exceptional circumstances. Any absences that are not explained either before or on the day of absence by 10am will be marked as unauthorised leave. Thank you for your cooperation.

#### Policy on returning to school after sickness or diarrhoea

School policy for returning after a diarrhoea or vomiting bug is 48 hours. However, if it is not a bug (not catchable), then they can return as soon as they feel well.

Examples of this could be: food poisoning, sick after having a coughing fit, sick due to a migraine, bowel issues such as irritable bowel, sick from eating too much food/drink, over tired.

#### Medical appointments

Routine appointments should not be taken in school time and should if possible be made after school or during a school holiday. If not possible, then please make as near to the end of the day as possible so that they do not miss too much school. If a hospital appointment, you don't get to choose a time, but can we ask that you bring them into school either before the appointment or after the appointment (depending on time), so that they miss as little of school as possible please? Can you also please send or show us evidence for any appointments please so we can mark them down as authorised? Thank you
